Preparing for a Real Estate Photo or Video Shoot

Part of this effort requires your cooperation in making sure your home is properly staged for your photo shoot. Please comply with the suggestions below before we arrive for the shoot to be sure the photos meet our standards. The photographer is not responsible for moving personal items of the client, for liability and efficiency reasons.

- Make sure all lights are functioning properly with no bulbs burnt out. Bulbs should "match" each other.
- Open all blinds and shades.
- Remove personal items and "knick knacks" from tables, mantels, counters, etc.
- Remove small rugs and carpets through out home.
- Remove any cardboard storage boxes and unnecessary items.
- Clear off window sills.
- Vacuum, sweep and dust. Our high resolution photos do show any dust or dirt.
- Remove religious items.
- Set up deck and patio areas. Remove grill covers, hoses and garbage cans as well as pool supplies etc.

Remove soap, bottles, sponges etc	floor.
Remove small appliances from counters.	Remove items from side tables. Tissues, remotes etc
Clear off refrigerator top and magnets.	Remove stuffed animals, laundry baskets etc.

Put away hoses, garbage cans, lawn tools.	Remove all soap and shampoo bottles, loofahs etc.
Move vehicles away from the shoot area.	Clean mirrors and metal fixtures.
